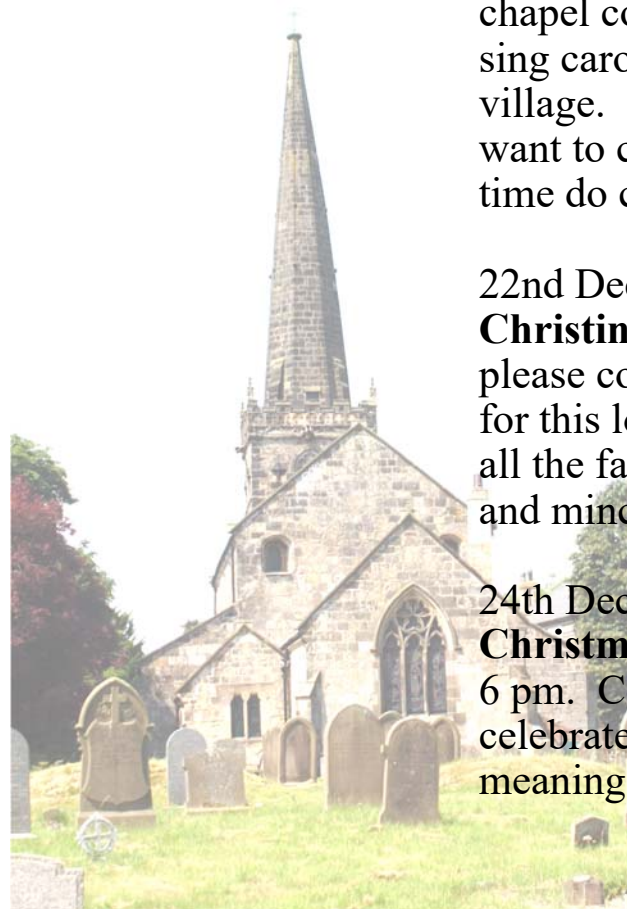

The safe and sound scheme allows people who may be vulnerable to apply for additional home security measures such as window locks, door chains or window alarms. To qualify applicants must be aged 60 or over or disabled and be a homeowner, private sector tenant of housing association tenant with a combined savings of everyone living in the household less than £23,250.
