The **village bus shelter** is getting an internal clean up and refurb! Which will include a new notice board.

Village **Post Office** service will be promoted with a permanent poster on the noticeboard in the bus shelter, together with a poster in the window where the Post Office is located every Tuesday 2-4 pm (at Church Farm). For the moment this will be instead of an A Frame board outside (as the last one broke after being blown down in the wind!) If, for any reason, the Post Office service isn't able to go ahead e.g. due to a technical failure then we will endeavour to let parishioners know as soon as possible via the WhatsApp information group.

Update re: **basket swing**: RoSPA post installation inspection was carried out on Monday 26th October, and after the necessary remedial works were carried out, the swing seat was attached for use on Wednesday 28th October. We advise parents/carers to check out where their children play. Adult supervision rules apply. Bench seating has been provided to the sides of the swing so that children can wait their turn or sit/lean and chat whilst watching friends. Adults are also able to sit there, and be close by, whilst supervising younger children. We know that many of your children have tried out the swing already and we wish to thank you all for the appreciation and hope they continue to enjoy and have fun!
