Councillor Leo Hammond {an East Riding Wolds Weighton Councillor} attended February's meeting. After being elected in May he has visited all Parish Councils in his Wolds Weighton ward. He introduced himself and explained that the three main issues affecting Parish Councils were:- 1) Dog Waste 2) Anti-social behaviour 3) Speeding. He will hopefully be able to help with seeking permission and approval from East Riding of Yorkshire Council for the traffic calming gateways that the Parish Council intend to purchase.

Some of you may have seen on the village facebook or WhatsApp group that **suspicious cars** have been noted in Huggate. Dark coloured Audi and Volkswagen Estate cars with blacked out windows have been spotted taking photos of houses.
